

Terms & Conditions

1st National Scientific Conference “AI in the Study of Mind and Behaviour: Rethinking Psychotherapy”

I. General Rules

§ 1

1. The First National Conference AI in the Study of Mind and Behavior, hereinafter referred to as “**the Conference,**” will be held on April 11, 2026, at the Faculty of Psychology, University of Warsaw, in Warsaw.
2. The Conference is organized by Psychology & Artificial Intelligence Research Lab (PAIR), operating at the Faculty of Psychology of the University of Warsaw, hereinafter referred to as the “**Organizer.**”
3. These rules and regulations will be published on the Conference event page on Facebook, as well as included in the registration form for participants and speakers.
4. The Terms and Conditions will be made available on **February 9, 2026.**

II. Participation rules

§ 2

1. Participation in this year’s edition of the Conference is free of charge for both passive and active participants.
2. In order to participate in the Conference as a passive participant, individuals are required to complete the registration form available on the Conference event page on Facebook or on the Organizer’s website.
3. The Organizer undertakes to inform participants who have submitted the registration form and confirmed their participation about the outcome of their application to the Conference.
4. The number of places for passive participants is limited. Admission to the Conference will be determined by the order in which completed registration forms are received.
5. Once the list of passive participants has been filled, a reserve list registration form will be made available. The order of submissions will determine the position on the

reserve list.

6. The Organizer reserves the right not to notify individuals that they have been placed on the reserve list.
7. If a place becomes available, the first person on the reserve list will be notified by email about the possibility of participating in the Conference. In order to be added to the list of passive participants, the individual must confirm their participation by email within the specified time limit.
8. If participation is not confirmed within the specified time limit, the individual will be removed from the list of passive participants, and the next person on the reserve list will be notified about the opportunity to participate in the Conference.
9. A **competition** will be held during the event. Rules for participation in the competition:
 - a. All participants of the 1st National Conference - AI in the Study of Mind and Behavior (hereinafter referred to as the “Conference”) who are not also its organizers are eligible to participate in the competition.
 - b. The competition will take place on the day of the Conference, i.e. April 11, 2026, at the Faculty of Psychology in Warsaw.
 - c. The competition is organized by the Student Club - Psychology & Artificial Intelligence Research Lab (PAIR), Faculty of Psychology, University of Warsaw
 - d. Prizes in the form of books donated by the sponsors of the 1st edition of the Conference will be awarded to the five people who asked the most questions to the speakers during the Conference. Each prize may vary in terms of both the number and type of books awarded. The organizer reserves the right to award book prizes in the Polish language.
 - e. In order to identify these people, they will be asked to give their name when asking a question. This data will only be processed on the day of the Conference in order to select the winners of the competition.
10. Participants are required to comply with the rules of the Faculty of Psychology at University of Warsaw and the rules of not recording or reproducing in any other way the speeches and presentations made during the Conference.
11. Participation in the Conference constitutes acceptance of the regulations.

§ 3

1. In order to participate in the Conference (active participation), a speaker is required to:
 - a. confirm participation in the Conference by email in response to the invitation sent by the Conference's Academic Committee and submit (by an individually specified deadline) a biographical note, the abstract of the presentation, and a photograph
 - b. complete and return the GDPR consent form received by email.
2. The Organizer reserves the right to select invited speakers and shall inform them of the decision by email.

§ 4

1. The Organizer shall provide participants with certificates of participation in electronic form within one month of the conclusion of the Conference.
2. The Organizer shall not be liable for any errors in the certificates resulting from the participant's fault (e.g. typographical errors in the participant's personal data).

III. Rules for presentations and conference agenda

§ 5

1. The detailed program of the Conference will be published on the Conference website, as well as on the Conference event page on Facebook and Instagram.
2. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the Conference program. Changes may concern, in particular, the order of presentations or the participation of announced speakers.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to hold the Conference at a different time or place due to circumstances beyond its control. The Organizer shall immediately inform the participants and speakers of the Conference of such circumstances.
4. In the cases referred to in § 5(2) and (3) of these regulations, participants shall not be entitled to compensation from the Organizer.

IV. Personal data

§ 6

1. The administrator of personal data is the Organizing Committee of the 1st Conference on AI in the Study of Mind and Behavior of the Student Research Club (PAIR) at the Faculty of Psychology, University of Warsaw, Stefana Banacha 2D, 02-097, Warsaw, NIP 525-001-12-66.
2. Participants' personal data is processed solely for purposes related to the organization of the Event.
3. Participants have the right to access their personal data, correct it, and request its removal. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the Conference.
4. The organizer reserves the right to use an external service to carry out registration.

V. Final provisions

§ 7

1. These regulations shall enter into force on the date of their publication on the Conference event page on Facebook.
2. In matters not covered by these regulations, the provisions of civil law shall apply.
